1 **A Resolution** concerning

3 **FY 2006 School Seat Allocations**

4  
5 **FOR** the purpose of distributing available school seats among the School Seat Allocation Pools for  
6 new residential development in the Town during the Town's ensuing fiscal year; and all  
7 matters generally relating thereto.

8  
9 **SECTION 1: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF**  
10 **LA PLATA** that, pursuant to Town Code Section 173, Article IX. School Seat Allocation Policy,  
11 there are hereby created School Seat Allocation Pools, and sub-pools as may be necessary, which are  
12 based on the number of school seats available for allocation in each fiscal year and the particularized  
13 student generation rate determined for a proposed subdivision or an existing lot or parcel of land, and  
14 which the Town determines will provide a reasonable apportionment of available school seats among  
15 competing development interests, all in accordance with the provisions of Town Code Section 173,  
16 Article IX. School Seat Allocation Policy.

18 **SECTION 2: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN**  
19 **OF LA PLATA** that the distribution of school seats among School Seat Allocation Pools shall be as  
20 follows:

21  
22 1. Proposed subdivisions consisting of at least 50 lots that have received preliminary plat  
23 approval and for which application has been made for final plat approval.

25 A) No allocations.

27 2. Proposed subdivisions consisting of less than 50 lots that have received preliminary  
28 plat approval and for which application has been made for final plat approval.

29  
30 A) Forty-five (45) seats.

31  
32 3. Lots in recorded subdivisions that have 50 or more remaining vacant lots for  
33 residential development. This pool shall contain not less than 20% of the school seat capacity  
34 available for allocation.

35  
36 A) Twenty (20) seats.

37  
38 4. Other existing recorded lots and parcels of land that could be developed for residential  
39 uses. This pool shall contain not less than 20% of the school seat capacity available for allocation.

41 A) Thirty-five (35) seats.
