5 **FOR** the purpose of adopting the schedule of holidays to be observed by the employees of the
6 Town of La Plata for FY2007-2008; and all matters relating to said schedule of holidays.

10 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the Town of La Plata,
11 certain paid holidays shall be observed by all employees of the Town, except sworn Police
12 Department employees who are governed by the Holiday Leave Policy of that department;

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF**
15 **LA PLATA** that the following holiday schedule be adopted for FY2007-2008, and be designated as
16 regular holidays on which the La Plata Town Hall will be closed:

19	Labor Day	Monday, September 3, 2007
20	★Veterans Day (observed)	Monday, November 12, 2007
21	Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 22, 2007
22	Friday after Thanksgiving	Friday, November 23, 2007
23	Christmas	Tuesday, December 25, 2007
24	New Year's	Tuesday, January 1, 2008
25	Martin Luther King Day	Monday, January 21, 2008
26	★Presidents Day	Monday, February 18, 2008
27	Good Friday	Friday, March 21, 2008
28	★Memorial Day (observed)	Monday, May 26, 2008

30 ★Flags shall fly on these days. In addition to the above noted holidays, flags shall be flown on Flag

31 Day (June 14), Election Days, and traditional Memorial Day (May 30).
