13 **SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA PLATA**
14 that Section 101-7.E. (2) of the Code of the Town of La Plata (1998) be and it is hereby repealed and
15 reenacted, with amendment, to read as follows:

17 **Chapter 101**
18 **FEES**

20 **§ 101-7. Refuse collection fees.**

21 All residential units within the Town of La Plata shall avail themselves of the Town
22 municipal refuse collection service. The quarterly refuse collection fee for all refuse collection within
23 the corporate limits of the Town of La Plata shall be as follows:

27 **E.** Outside corporate limits:
28 (1) Residential curbside: Ninety-six dollars (\$96.00) per quarter. This service is
29 subject to Town Council approval.

30 (2) A surcharge of nine dollars and ((fifty)) SIXTY cents ((((\$9.50))) (\$9.60) will be
31 collected from each utility account to pay for the recycling project.
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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of fifteen (15) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
