3 **INTERNATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE–ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS 2006**
4

5 **FOR** the purpose of adopting the International Electrical Code-Administrative Provisions 2006,
6 with certain modifications, as the code for the regulation, and control of the design,
7 construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation,
8 replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of electrical systems in the Town of La Plata;
9 providing for the administration and enforcement of that code; specifying penalties for
10 violations; providing that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable; and all matters generally
11 related thereto.

22 **SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA PLATA,**
23 That Sections 75-5 and 75-5.1 of the Code of the Town of La Plata (1998 Edition and Supplements)
24 be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

26 **Chapter 75 – BUILDING CONSTRUCTION**
27 **Article III. Electrical Code**

29 **75-5. Adoption of standards; copies on file.**
30

31 Subject to the provisions of §75-5.1, there is hereby adopted by the Town of La Plata for the
32 purpose of regulating and controlling the design, construction, quality of materials, erection,
33 installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of
34 electrical systems in the Town of La Plata the International Electrical Code-Administrative Provisions
35 ((2003)) 2006, as published by the International Code Council. Not less than one (1) copy of the
36 International Electrical Code-Administrative Provisions ((2003)) 2006 shall be kept on file in the office of
37 the Town Clerk.

39 **75-5.1 Modifications.**

40 The International Electrical Code-Administrative Provisions 2006, as adopted by §75-5, is
41 modified as set forth below:

44 A. In the second [[and third lines]] LINE of Section 101.1 on page 1, in the space labeled

52 O. Section 1101.1 on page 21 is deleted, and new Section ((110.1)) 1101.1 is substituted,
53 to read as follows:

54 **1101.1 Appeals to Board of Appeals:** The board of appeals provided for in Chapter 9 of the Code
55 of the Town of La Plata may hear and decide appeals of orders, decisions or determinations of the
56 code official relating to the application and interpretation of this code. All appeals filed pursuant to
57 Section 1103.1 shall be governed by the provisions of such Chapter 9 and by any rules of procedure
58 adopted by the Board of Appeals pursuant to Chapter 9.

61 Q. SECTION 1103, “PROCEDURES”, ON PAGE 21 IS DELETED.

63 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That if any provision of this Ordinance, or the
64 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not
65 affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the
66 invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to
67 be severable.

69 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Ordinance shall become effective at
70 the expiration of fifteen (15) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
