Matters of Council Discussion

1. Topics for discussion with the County Commissioners at biannual meeting on **May 19**.
 - Description: The Town Council will determine what topics they want included on the agenda of the next biannual meeting of the Town Council, Town of Indian Head, and County Commissioners, which is scheduled to be held on **May 19** and will begin at 4:00 p.m., at the La Plata Town Hall. Topics already on the agenda are:
 - (1) School Seat Allocation funding (Councilman Newman wishes to discuss funds placement in County's General Fund).
 - (2) 2010 Biannual meeting schedule of the Towns of La Plata and Indian Head and County Commissioners [*date/location*]: Spring and fall dates [*date/location: spring and fall – typically April or May, October*].
2. Intensity of rental use in residential dwellings.
 - Description: Discussion of the number of rental occupants in residential dwellings in the Town.
3. Commercial vehicles in residential neighborhoods
 - Description: Discussion will include (1) what constitutes a “commercial vehicle” – with or without advertising; (2) definitions of “gross vehicle weight” and “vehicle capacity” – both terms used in Town Code (§ 181-3 and § 191-28; (3) definitions of “commercial vehicles” from other municipal codes; (4) enforcement issue – need to check on weekends and after hours; (5) how a change in the Code would impact residents who currently store commercial vehicles in residential neighborhoods; (6) what is specifically prohibited.
4. Budget
 - Description: Mr. Oliphant will discuss FY10 budget items with the Council.
