Mayor Hale called the work session to order at 7:04 PM.

► **Matters of Council Discussion**

(2) Chapter 117, Article III Refuse

Mr. Mears presented draft language to Chapter 117, Article III Refuse, to address the concerns of the Council as a result of the implementation of the Automated Trash Collection System.

Council Consensus: Following discussion the Council agreed to Introduce an Ordinance with the language as presented at the July 26, 2011 business meeting.

(3) Application(s) to Design Review Board and Parks and Recreation Commission

Councilmen Norris and Winkler discussed the applications to serve on the Design Review Board and Parks and Recreation Commission.

Council Consensus: Following discussion the Council agreed that the Chairman of the Design Review Board and the Parks and Recreation Commission, with the ex officio member shall interview the prospective applicants and forward a report and recommendation to the Council.

(4) iPad 2 Training

Mr. Mears and Ms. Mandley provided information and training and answered questions regarding the use of the iPad 2 devices for meeting packet delivery.

►Matters of Information

- Caroline Drive

Councilman Winkler referred to an email from a resident of Caroline Drive and the request to rename the two (2) separate portions of the road to East Caroline Drive and West Caroline Drive.

Council Consensus: Following discussion the Council agreed to have the requestor gather the support of the affected residents and to discuss further once information regarding the community support is received.

- CSX Railroad Crossing – Charles Street

Mayor Hale provided an update to the Council regarding the request that the CSX Railroad Crossing on Charles Street be repaired, which is currently on the CSX repair schedule.
