3 **INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE 2006**

5 **FOR** the purpose of adopting the International Energy Conservation Code 2006, with certain
6 modifications, as the energy conservation code for the Town of La Plata; providing for the
7 administration and enforcement of that code; specifying penalties for violations; providing that
8 the provisions of this Ordinance are severable; and all matters generally related thereto.

19 **SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA PLATA,**
20 That Sections 75-8 and 75-9 of the Code of the Town of La Plata (1998 Edition and Supplements) be
21 and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

23 **Chapter 75 – BUILDING CONSTRUCTION**
24 **Article V. Energy Code**

26 **75-8. Adoption of standards; copies on file.**

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28 Subject to the provisions of § 75-9, there is hereby adopted by the Town of La Plata for the
29 purpose of establishing minimum standards governing the consumption of energy resources in
30 buildings and structures in the town, a certain document entitled the International Energy
31 Conservation Code 2006, as published by the International Code Council. Not less than one (1) copy

32 of the International Energy Conservation Code 2006 shall be kept on file in the office of the Town
33 Clerk.

35 **75-9 Modifications.**

37 The International Energy Conservation Code ((2003)) 2006, as adopted by § 75-8, is modified
38 as set forth below:

40 B. Section 107.1 on page ((4)) 3 is revised to read as follows:

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42 **107.1 Referenced standards:** The standards and portions thereof, referenced in this code and
43 listed in Chapter ((10)) 6 shall be considered part of the requirements of this code to the
44 prescribed extent of each such reference, except to the extent that any of such standards have
45 been expressly modified in the Code of the Town of La Plata. Where differences occur between
46 the provisions of this code and the referenced standards, the provisions of this code shall apply.

48 C. New Section 107.3 is added on page ((4)) 3, to read as follows:

52 D. New Sections 108.1 and 108.2 are added on page ((4)) 3, to be under the new Section 108,
53 “Enforcement” and to read as follows:

57 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That if any provision of this Ordinance, or the
58 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not
59 affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the
60 invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to
61 be severable.

63 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Ordinance shall become effective at
64 the expiration of fifteen (15) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
