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1 **An Ordinance** concerning

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3 **INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE 2006**

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5 **FOR** the purpose of adopting the International Plumbing Code 2006, with certain modifications, as  
6 the plumbing code for the Town of La Plata; providing for the administration and  
7 enforcement of that code; specifying penalties for violations; providing that the provisions of this  
8 Ordinance are severable; and all matters generally related thereto.

13 Chapter 150 – PLUMBING STANDARDS  
14 Sections 150-1 and 150-2  
15 Code of the Town of La Plata  
16 (1998 Edition and Supplements)

18 **SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA PLATA,**  
19 That Sections 150-1 and 150-2 of the Code of the Town of La Plata (1998 Edition and Supplements)  
20 be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

22 **Chapter 150 – PLUMBING STANDARDS**

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24 **150-1. Adoption of standards; copies on file.**

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26 Subject to the provisions of §150-2, there is hereby adopted by the Town of La Plata for the  
27 purpose of establishing minimum standards governing the design, installation and construction of  
28 plumbing systems in the town, a certain document entitled The International Plumbing Code ((2003))  
29 2006, as published by the International Code Council. Not less than one (1) copy of the International  
30 Plumbing Code ((2003)) shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

32 **150-2 Modifications.**

33 The International Plumbing Code ((2003)) 2006, as adopted by §150-1, is modified as set  
34 forth below:

36 J. In the first ((line)) AND SECOND LINES of Section 106.5.3 on page 4, delete “by  
37 the code official.”

41 L. Section 106.6.3 on pages 4 and 5 is revised to read as follows:

43 **106.6.3 Fee refunds:** The Code Official shall authorize the refunding of the full amount of  
44 any fee that was erroneously paid or collected. The Code ((official)) OFFICIAL shall not  
45 authorize the refunding of any fee paid, except upon written application filed by the original  
46 permittee not later than 180 days after the date of the fee payment.

48 P. Sections 109.2 through 109.7, inclusive, on ((pages 6 and)) PAGE 7 ((is)) ARE  
49 deleted, and new Section 109.2 is substituted, to read as follows:

51 **109.2 Board of Appeals:** The board of appeals referred to in Section 109.1 is the same board  
52 of appeals provided for in Chapter 9 of the Code of the Town of La Plata. All appeals filed  
53 pursuant to Section 109.1 shall be governed by the provisions of Chapter 9 and by any rules  
54 of procedure adopted by the board of appeals pursuant to Chapter 9.

56 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That if any provision of this Ordinance, or the  
57 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not  
58 affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the  
59 invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to  
60 be severable.

61 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Ordinance shall become effective at  
62 the expiration of fifteen (15) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
