3 **INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE 2006**

5 **FOR** the purpose of adopting the International Fuel Gas Code 2006, with certain modifications, as
6 the code for the regulation and control of the design and installation of fuel gas systems and
7 gas-fired appliances in the Town of La Plata; providing for the administration and
8 enforcement of that code; specifying penalties for violations; providing that the provisions of this
9 Ordinance are severable; and all matters generally related thereto.

20 **SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA PLATA,**
21 That Sections 75-13 and 75-14 of the Code of the Town of La Plata (1998 Edition and Supplements)
22 be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

24 **Chapter 75 – BUILDING CONSTRUCTION**
25 **Article VII. Fuel Gas Code**

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27 **75-13. Adoption of standards; copies on file.**

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29 Subject to the provisions of §75-14, there is hereby adopted by the Town of La Plata for the
30 purpose of regulating and controlling the design and installation of fuel gas systems and gas-fired
31 appliances in the Town of La Plata the International Fuel Gas Code ((2003)) 2006, as published by the

32 International Code Council. Not less than one (1) copy of the International Fuel Gas Code ((2003)) 2006
33 shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk.
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35 **75-14 Modifications.**

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37 The International Fuel Gas Code ((2003)) 2006, as adopted by §75-13, is modified as set forth
38 below:

42 B. Section 102.8 on page 2 is revised to read as follows:

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44 **102.8 Referenced codes and standards:** The codes and standards referenced in this code shall
45 BE those listed in Chapter 8 and shall be considered part of the requirements of this code to the
46 prescribed extent of each such reference, except to the extent that any of such standards have been
47 expressly modified in the Code of the Town of La Plata. Where differences occur between the
48 provisions of this code and the referenced codes and standards, the provisions of this code shall
49 apply.

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51 **Exception:** Where enforcement of a code provision would violate the conditions of the listing of
52 the equipment or appliance, the conditions of the listing and manufacturer’s instructions shall
53 apply.

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57 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That if any provision of this Ordinance, or the
58 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not
59 affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the
60 invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to
61 be severable.

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63 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Ordinance shall become effective at
64 the expiration of fifteen (15) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
