1 **An Emergency Ordinance concerning**

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3 **Amendment to Town of La Plata FY2009-2010 Financial Plan/Budget**

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5 **FOR** the purpose of amending the Town of La Plata FY2009-2010 Financial Plan/Budget; and
6 all matters generally relating thereto.

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8 **WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the Council of the Town of La Plata, by this emergency
9 ordinance to accept and appropriate grant funds provided by the State of Maryland Department
10 of Natural Resources; and

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12 **WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the Council of the Town of La Plata, by this emergency
13 ordinance to accept and appropriate grant funds provided by the United State Department of
14 Justice/Bureau of Justice Programs/Bureau of Justice Assistance. Now therefore:

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16 **SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF**
17 **LA PLATA** that the Town of La Plata FY2009-2010 Financial Plan/Budget be amended to
18 appropriate the \$114,000.00 Community Parks and Playground Grant being provided by the
19 State of Maryland Department of Natural Resources into accounts 102-000-33200-000 – MD
20 DNR Revenue and 102-630-53000-090, for the purpose of installing new playground equipment
21 at the existing neighborhood parks on Caroline Drive and Patuxent Court and resurfacing the
22 tennis courts in Wills and Silver Linden Parks.

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24 **SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE**
25 **TOWN OF LA PLATA** the Town of La Plata FY2009-2010 Financial Plan/Budget be amended
26 to appropriate the \$19,304.00 the FY09 Recovery Act Byrne Grant from the United State
27 Department of Justice/Bureau of Justice Programs/Bureau of Justice Assistance into accounts
28 110-000-33212-000 – DOJ Revenue and 110-310-52000-090, for the purpose of wirelessly
29 linking the mobile display terminals in the Town's patrol vehicles to the Town's CODY records
30 management system.

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




