3 **INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE 2009**

5 **FOR** the purpose of adopting the International Fuel Gas Code 2009, with certain modifications,
6 as the code for the regulation and control of the design and installation of fuel gas
7 systems and gas-fired appliances in the Town of La Plata; providing for the
8 administration and enforcement of that code; specifying penalties for violations; providing
9 that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable; and all matters generally related thereto.

20 **SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA**
21 **PLATA**, That Sections 75-13 and 75-14 of the Code of the Town of La Plata (1998 Edition and
22 Supplements) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as
23 follows:

25 **Chapter 75 – BUILDING CONSTRUCTION**
26 **Article VII. Fuel Gas Code**

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28 **75-13. Adoption of standards; copies on file.**

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30 Subject to the provisions of §75-14, there is hereby adopted by the Town of La Plata for the
31 purpose of regulating and controlling the design and installation of fuel gas systems and gas-fired
32 appliances in the Town of La Plata the International Fuel Gas Code ((2006)) 2009, as published by
33 the International Code Council. Not less than one (1) copy of the International Fuel Gas Code ((
34 2006)) 2009 shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

36 **75-14 Modifications.**

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38 The International Fuel Gas Code ((2006)) 2009, as adopted by §75-13, is modified as set
39 forth below:

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43 E. ((Section 104.2 on page 3 is deleted in its entirety.))

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45 F. In the second line of Section ((104.3)) 104.2 on page 3, delete "issue" and substitute
46 "authorize the issuance of."

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48 G. In the last line of Section ((106.4)) 106.5 on page 4, immediately after "issued to the
49 applicant" insert "by the Town."

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51 H. In the second line of Section ((106.4.1)) 106.5.1 on page 4, delete (("issues")) "CODE
52 OFFICIAL ISSUES" and substitute "THE TOWN AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE OF."

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54 I. ((In the first line of the second paragraph of Section 106.4.1 on page 4, delete "issue" and
55 substitute "authorize the issuance of."))

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57 J. ((In the first and second lines of Section 106.4.3 on page 4, delete "by the code official."))

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59 K. Section ((106.5.2)) 106.6.2 on page 5 is revised to read as follows:
60 **((106.5.2)) 106.6.2 Fee Schedule:** The fees for all work for which a permit is required by this code
61 shall be as prescribed by ordinance adopted by the Town Council from time to time.

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63 L. Section ((106.5.3)) 106.6.3 on page 5 is revised to read as follows:
64 **((106.5.3)) 106.6.3 Refund:** The code official shall authorize the refunding of the full amount of
65 any fee that was erroneously paid or collected. The building official shall not authorize the
66 refunding of any fee paid, except upon written application filed by the original permittee not later
67 than 180 days after the date of the fee payment.

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71 O. The last sentence of Section 108.5 on page ((6)) 7is revised to read as follows:

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75 Q. The definition of "CODE OFFICIAL" as contained in Section 202 on page 10 is revised to
76 read as follows:

77 **CODE OFFICIAL:** The ((director of the department)) MANAGER of inspections of the Town, or
78 such other person as the town's chief executive officer may designate.



AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.






